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CONSENT FORM FOR SCHOOL TRIPS AND OTHER OFF-SITE ACTIVITIES

At Roe Green Junior School, we encourage learning through trips and visits to various educational premises in and around Greater London. In these instances, the school will send you information about each trip or activity before it takes place. Written parental consent will not be requested from you for a majority of off-site visits offered by the school – for example, local year group visits. Such activities are a part of the school curriculum and usually take place during the normal school day.

The trips and activities covered by this consent include:

- All visits that take place both during the school day and outside normal school hours
- Off-site sporting events that take place during the school day and outside normal school hours
