Reminders:

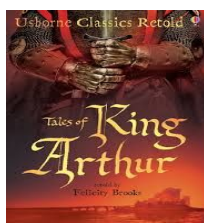
If you need to change your child's lunch arrangements eg. school dinners to packed lunch, please give **1 week's notice to Ms Vekaria** in the school office.
