SATs

SATs week for Year 6 is week commencing Monday 11th May 2026. Year 6 team will be running some Maths booster sessions this term. These sessions will be during lunch time, depending on your child maths set. Please do not be alarmed if they come home and tell you they have missed 30 mins of their lunch time.

Literacy

This term we will explore a range of poetry and non-fiction texts. Children will also develop their persuasive and suspense story writing. We explore grammar, spelling and comprehension daily.



Maths

Children must practise their times tables and use their key skills books to practice their work at home. They will use MyMaths to recap their learning. Children are in groups suited to their learning. Groups are fluid and children may move accordingly.



Science

In this term we study two topics:

- Evolution and Inheritance
- Electricity

Children will carry out experiments and investigations to learn about the above topics.



History and Geography

This term we are learning about the ancient civilization of Benin as part of History learning.

In Geography will be focusing on Greece as part of our study of a European country.



Wider curriculum

At RGJS we believe in the importance of teaching the 'whole child', making sure your child receives a broad and rich curriculum, including

PE: Tag rugby and gymnastics

Art/DT: Perspective drawing & sewing felt phone cases

Music: Samba and singing **Spanish:** Professions and sports

Computing: Programming games, Data and spreadsheets
