## Science

Our science topic for summer is Plants, and we will be learning about plant growth, and the role of plants in ecosystems. We will be visiting the Welsh Harp for workshops on plants and pollination

# Geography

During Geography week this term, we will be looking at Rivers within the UK and internationally, as well as water as a resource.

#### Wider curriculum

During the summer term, we will continue to enjoy a broad range of learning activities across the curriculum, including:
