BBC Bitesize and Oak National Academy

In order to maintain learning, we would like children to complete **at least 3** English and **at least 3** Maths daily lessons, **as well as 3 other lessons** (eg. Geography, PSHCE, art) from the other offered subjects across the week from **either** Oak Academy, or BBC Bitesize, depending on the needs of your child.

With this in mind, you may wish to access lessons from different age groups depending on how easy or difficult your child finds the activities. Video sessions will be available on weekdays tailored to different age groups. BBC Bitesize will be available on Red Button and BBC On Demand. Selection of the lessons you wish your child to complete will depend on their interests, and areas you may wish them to focus on. Flexibility is essential during this situation, so ensuring a broad range of topics may be helpful in keeping children focussed on learning.
