## TOPIC & COMPUTING

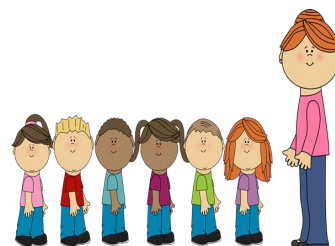
Our topic this term is 'Where are we in the World?'. In computing we will be focusing on 'Desktop Publishing' and 'Computer systems and networks'.

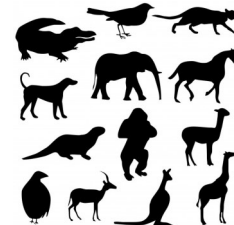
## ART
