21st November: Brent Museum trip 3R and 3S

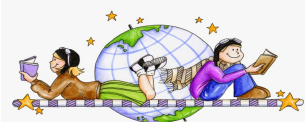

Literacy



Topics this term are **Michael**

Rosen's poetry and **The Tunnel by Anthony Browne**.

Spellings will be sent home each week. Please read with your child for 20 minutes each night.

Maths



We will be focussing on many topics throughout the term, including place value, number bonds to 100, times tables, addition and subtraction and number and word problems. Please practise at least the 3, 4, 6, and 8 times tables with your child.

Science



In science this term our topics are

Animals including humans this includes nutrition, the skeleton and muscles. **Rocks, under our feet** includes soil types. We make our lessons as practical as possible and encourage children to enquire about areas of interest at home, eg fossils.

History and Geography



Our history topic is the **Stone Age to the Iron Age**. Geography will be taught in blocks later in the term. Our topic will be **UK and World Knowledge**, with a focus on map skills.

Wider curriculum

At RGJS we believe in the importance of teaching the 'whole child', making sure your child receives a broad and rich curriculum, including;

PE: Gymnastics and movement games **Art:** Stone Age art and D.T. healthy lunches **Music:** Ensemble work and singing games **Computing:** Networks and animation

Swimming is a statutory part of the curriculum. Your child is expected to be able to swim a minimum of 25 metres by the end of Year 6. We are fortunate to have our own pool and a very experienced swimming teacher.
